



## **Application Form: Micromine Training Courses**

Our introductory and advanced training courses are led by experienced professionals, and are delivered on a quarterly basis from our London office:

- Introduction to Micromine will teach you how to use the basics of your Micromine software, and is accredited by The Geological Society. The two-day course is for new and returning users, or managers that need a basic level of understanding to interact with their technical staff.
  - Key features that will be introduced include data entry and importing, visual integration of different 2D and 3D data using the Vizex (Visual Explorer) interface, generating drillhole sections and producing printed output.
- The two-day Resource Estimation in Micromine advanced training course will provide a theoretical and practical overview of mineral resource estimation tools in Micromine.
  - From exploratory data analysis to grade interpretation, resource classification and block model reporting, participants will gain an overview of the real world application of resource estimation techniques.

## **Information**

- The discounted rate of £110 for the Introduction to Micromine course is offered to students, unemployed or underemployed registrants (working less than 20 hours per week). The discounted rate is not available to individuals working as consultants.
- A completed registration form and advanced payment in full is required before your place on this course will be confirmed, as places are limited and allocated on a first come first served basis.

- To attend the Resource Estimation course delegates must have completed our Introduction to Micromine course or demonstrate that they are competent users of Micromine.
