Application

This Policy applies to customer use of the Micromine Origin Grade Copilot feature in conjunction with Micromine Nexus.

Policy Statement

Micromine aims to establish and maintain a sensible limit to the use of Cloud Computing Time associated with use of the Micromine Origin Grade Copilot feature.

Purpose

This Policy defines a limit to the use of Cloud Computing Time associated with use of Micromine Origin Grade Copilot.

Excessive use of Cloud Computing Time by a user may degrade the user experience of other Grade Copilot or Nexus users, by slowing down application response times.

To avoid these potential issues, a fair use limit is established by this Policy.

Fair use of Grade Copilot

The fair use limit of Cloud Computing Time for Grade Copilot is:

- 30 hours of Cloud Computing Time per month per individual licence.
- 45 hours of Cloud Computing Time per month per network licence seat.

Excessive use of Grade Copilot

Breach of the fair use limit may result in contact by a Micromine representative to enquire about the nature of the usage. User feedback can be considered in Policy review.

Repeated breach of the fair use limit (and after discussion with the Micromine representative) may result in suspension of the Grade Copilot feature for the license for the remainder of the calendar month, at Micromine's discretion.
