

END-USER LICENSE AGREEMENT

Revision 5.0 – 29 April 2024

Important - Read carefully:

This End-User License Agreement ("EULA") is a legal agreement between and binding each person using Micromine's software and including the company employing those persons ("you" and "User") and Micromine Australia Pty Ltd ABN 72 630 329 118 ("Micromine"). It applies to all Software Products made available by Micromine in the Micromine Alastri product suite, including the products known as "Alastri Haul Infinity" or "Alastri Rapid Reserver" or "Alastri Tactical Scheduler" or "Alastri Production Scheduler" or "Alastri Spatial Conformetrics" or other software products identified as Micromine's Software, and may include associated media, printed materials, and "online" or electronic documentation (together "Software Product"). The Software Product also includes any updates and supplements to original software provided by Micromine.

By installing, copying, or otherwise using the Software Product, each User agrees to be bound by the terms of this EULA. If you do not agree to any of the terms of this EULA, you are not permitted to install or use the Software Product in any way, and all copies of it must be deleted from your system(s).

By clicking "accept" and proceeding with installation of the Software Products you are representing you are a duly authorised member of the company's personnel and have the authority to bind that company to this EULA.

The Software Product is protected by copyright laws and international copyright treaties, as well as other intellectual property laws and treaties. Where the Software Product is licensed you must cease to use it when the Software Product licence ends or terminates.

1. **RIGHTS SUBJECT TO LICENSE.** You agree to use the Software Product in accordance with, and only during the period of, a valid licence granted by Micromine to your employer ("Software Licence"), and in all the terms and conditions of this EULA. You agree to cease to use the Software Product if your employer does not hold a valid Software Licence for it. By using the Software Product, you represent and warrant to Micromine that you are doing so in accordance with the terms of a current and valid Software Licence.
2. **DESCRIPTION OF OTHER RIGHTS AND LIMITATIONS.**
 - a. **COPYRIGHT.** All title and copyrights in and to the Software Product (including but not limited to any images, photographs, text, and "applets" incorporated into the Software Product), the accompanying printed materials, and any copies of the Software Product are owned by Micromine. The Software Product is protected by copyright laws and international treaty provisions. Therefore, you must treat the Software Product like any other copyrighted material, and may not copy it, except as expressly permitted under the Software Licence.
 - b. **No Commercial Exploitation:** You may not provide or make available copies of, rent, lease or sub-licence or disseminate in any other manner the Software Product to any third party. You may not use (or permit any other person to use) the Software Product for the benefit of, or the purpose of providing services to, any third party (including without limitation, processing data for or on behalf of a third party).
 - c. **Proprietary notices.** You may not remove any proprietary notices or labels on the Software Product.
 - d. **Termination.** Without prejudice to any other rights, Micromine may terminate the Software Licence and any rights you have under this EULA if you fail to comply with the terms and conditions of this EULA. Micromine shall be entitled to damages for your breach and for loss of your obligations under this EULA and the Software Licence.
 - e. **Term.** This EULA shall continue to apply to your use of the Software Product, even if you do so after expiry of the Software Licence (in breach of this EULA).

- f. **Derived Works.** You agree that you will not use the Software Product to develop derived works that offer similar functionality to the Software Product for use by unlicensed parties nor will you expose any of the features of the Software Product for use by an unlicensed third party. You may develop derived works as long as usage of those derived works is for use by the company holding the Software Licence, and any derived work which is software, also requires the usage of a current Software Licence. Any such derived work being software shall be subject to the terms of this EULA, and you shall cease using that derived work upon ceasing to be entitled to use the Software Product.
- g. **Disassembly or Reverse Engineering.** You may not modify the Software Product in any manner. You shall not, nor allow others to copy, in whole or in part, emulate, sub-license, sell, transfer, exploit, alter, modify or adapt the Software Product nor decompile, decrypt, disassemble or reverse engineer the Software Product or any part of it nor attempt to do such thing.
3. **UNAUTHORISED USE.** If you use any Software Product without being entitled to do so under a current and valid Software Licence, you agree to pay to Micromine liquidated damages for such use equal to Micromine’s then current monthly licence fee for the Software Product for each calendar month, or part of a calendar month you use the Software Product. You agree not to access, use, or (directly or indirectly) allow use, of the Software in, from, or for the benefit of any party in the jurisdictions of Russia, the Democratic People’s Republic of Korea, Iran, Syria, Libya or other sanctioned jurisdiction(s) as nominated by Micromine from time to time, and Micromine reserves the right to terminate this EULA and you agree to forfeit any payments made to Micromine if you breach this provision.
4. **DISCLAIMER.** The Software Products are provided “as is”, without warranties to any User of any kind. Any warranties are provided to the holder of the Software Licence only, and are governed by Micromine’s agreement with that holder. Micromine does not take any responsibility for any damage suffered by a User as a result of using, modifying or distributing the Software Product or any information derived from their use.
5. **LANGUAGE OF AGREEMENT.** You agree that this EULA and any communications in respect of it will be in the English language.
6. **GOVERNING LAW.** This EULA is governed by and is to be construed in accordance with laws of the State of Western Australia, Australia. Each party irrevocably submits to the jurisdiction of the courts of that place.

This EULA and the Micromine Alastri product suite SLA terms available at <https://www.micromine.com/licensing/> apply to the exclusion of any other terms that the User seeks to impose or incorporate (including any terms or conditions contained in any correspondence, purchase order, vendor terms or other documentation from the User), or which are implied by trade, custom, practice or course of dealing. Any terms or conditions attached to any purchase order issued by the User in respect of the Software Products (other than this EULA) will not form part of the EULA unless such conditions are expressly accepted by Micromine in writing.
